Notes
(1) To complete the graduate program, graduate students in the department are required to take at least 30 credits, including 15 credits from required courses and 15 credits from elective courses. (2) The number of credits allowed to be obtained in each semester is limited. Regular students can only obtain 3 to 12 credits in each of the first 3 semesters. Part-time students can only obtain 3 to 9 credits in each of the first 4 semesters. (3) Students cannot take elective courses from other graduate programs offered by the department without the consent from the head of the graduate program. In total, students can obtain no more than 6 credits from elective courses from other graduate programs.
