- Article I The National Central University Remarkable New Teaching and Research Faculty Award Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) is formulated for recruiting remarkable teachers to NCU for academic research and teaching so as to improve the academic standards of NCU.
- Article II The funding source for these Regulations shall come from the funds raised by NCU and income from other government grants.
- Article III The award shall be applicable to both tenure-track and non-tenure-track (project) teaching and research faculty in NCU who is not appointed at the first time domestic and who meets one of the following criteria; they may apply for the award from one year prior to appointment to within three years from the date of starting employment:
 - 1. Have won a national award (such as the Ministry of Science and Technology Outstanding Research Award, the Designated Research Fellow Award, the Ministry of Education Academic Awards, National Chair Professorship, outstanding scholar conference awards from the

Foundation for the Advancement of Outstanding Scholarships, the Executive Yuan Outstanding Technology Award, the National Culture and Arts Award, the Executive Yuan Culture and Arts Award, or other comparable award).

- 2. Have authored journal papers or monographs with major academic contributions.
- 3. Have achieved outstanding outcome in industry-academia collaboration, transferred the research results to the industry, and achieved a major contribution.
- 4. Hold important positions or have been awarded important awards in domestic or foreign academic organizations, and have demonstrated outstanding academic achievements.
- Article IV Application for this award shall be submitted by departments (institutes) and colleges (centers) before the end of June or December each year. To apply, attach the recommendation form, the minutes of recommendation meetings convened by the teacher evaluation committees of the respective department (institute), college (center), and the following documents to the Research and Development Office:
 - 1. Personal basic information form.
 - 2. Catalogue of works.
 - 3. Brief description of research results.
 - 4. Photocopies of certificates for special honors and special awards.
- Article V Recommendations and related proposals for this award shall be deliberated by the Research Award Review Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee). Regulations for the establishment of the Committee shall be separately formulated.
- Article VI In general, NCU and its colleges and departments shall be jointly responsible for the award money. The amount of the award shall be deliberated by the NCU Research Award Review Committee. The award shall be disbursed to the award recipient once every six months; the maximum period for receiving the award is three years.

The award funding source is donors. The award may be allocated in installments, in accordance with the items designated in the National Central University Donations to University Endowment Funds Regulations.

Article VII Award winners shall not receive the award until they have arrived at their posts. Those who resign or retire during the award period shall have their award terminated. Those who are on leave of absence without pay, on temporary transfer, or under disciplinary action shall not have their award disbursed until they have resumed or returned to their unit or until their disciplinary period has ended, respectively.

Those who have received chair professorship or other awards from NCU shall choose either this or the other award; however, the Luo Jialun Outstanding Young Researcher Award shall not be subject to this provision. Those who have received chair professorship from outside of NCU shall have this award suspended until said chair professorship has ended; only then may this award be resumed.

- Article VIII Recipients of the award in these Regulations shall submit a performance report to the Research Award Review Committee each year for review.
- Article IX These Regulations are implemented upon approval by the Research and Development Meeting and the University Endowment Fund Committee; the same applies to any amendments.
