Luo Jialun Outstanding Young Researcher Award Establishment

Regulations

Approved on June 19, 2017 by the 656th Administrative Meeting.

Article I (Purpose)

National Central University (hereinafter referred to as NCU) has formulated these Regulations to cultivate young teaching and research faculty, encourage young academic elites to dedicate themselves to long-term academic research, and to commemorate Mr. Luo Jialun.

Article II (Funding Source)

The funding for this award is donations from Ms. Lo Jiu-Hwa to NCU.

Article III (Application Criteria) Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- (1) Current tenure-track (non-tenure-track, project) teaching and research faculty of NCU.
- (2) Age 45 years old or younger.
- (3) Have made significant academic contributions in the name of NCU, achieved outstanding results in the implementation of industry-academia collaboration, or won important young awards at home and abroad (such as the Ta-You Wu Memorial Award from the Ministry of Science and Technology, the Academia Sinica Junior Research Investigators Award, or other comparable awards).

Article IV (Application Documents)

To apply, submit the minutes for the teacher evaluation committee meetings of the respective department (institute), college (center) and the following documents to the Research and Development Office:

- (1) Personal basic information form.
- (2) Catalogue of works.
- (3) Brief description of research results.
- (4) Photocopies of certificates for special honors and special awards.
- (5) One or more letters of recommendation.
- (6) Other relevant materials that are favorable to the review.

Article V (Award Method)

- (1) In general, there shall be 2 to 4 award winners per year.
- (2) An award of NT\$600,000 shall be disbursed on a monthly basis over a period of one year.
- (3) Award winners shall be limited to receiving one award.

Article VI (Composition of Selection Committee)

The University President shall appoint the University Vice President, the Dean of Research and Development, the Dean of Academic Affairs, and scholars and experts from inside and outside the university to form a nine-member selection committee, and appoint a convener from among the members. Other than members who are appointed because of their positions, the term of office for scholar and expert members shall be three years.

Reviews shall be completed within three months from the day following the application deadline each year, and review outcomes shall be announced.

Article VII (Regulations Amendment Procedure)

These Regulations are implemented upon approval by the Administrative Meeting and the University Endowment Fund Committee Meeting; the same applies to any amendments.
